**News:**

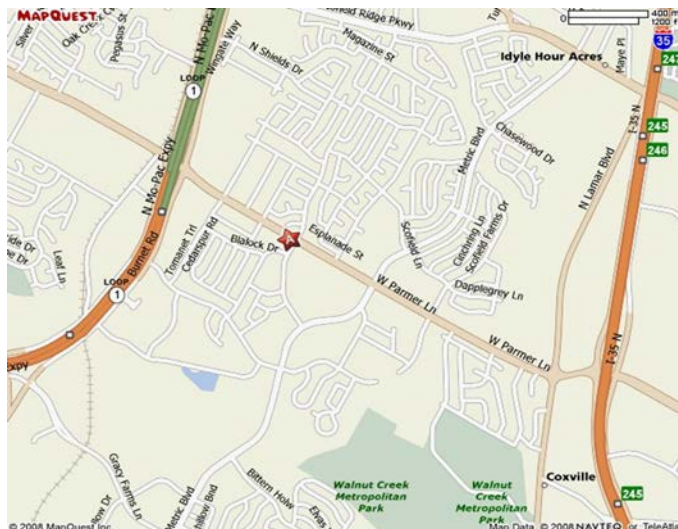
